

## PayAnyone references in New Internet Banking

When using the new Internet Banking, how you manage payment references is slightly different. The reference is no longer stored in a separate reference screen. However, you do not need to retype your favourite references, as the last three transaction references that were used, now appear when making a payment to the Payee.

### Classic PayAnyone screen

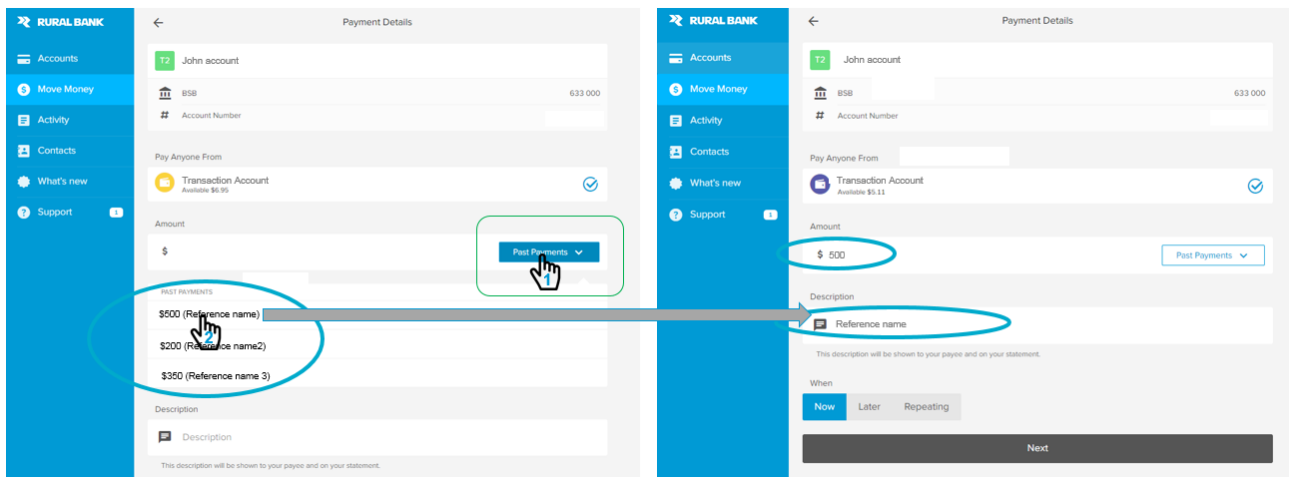
**Note:** Payments entered prior to 7:00pm on a Banking Business Day will reach the 'to account' the next Banking Business Day. Payments entered after 7:00pm on a Banking Business Day, or at anytime on a Weekend or Public Holiday still debit your account immediately but will require an additional Banking Business Day to reach the 'to account'.

The reference field in Classic is replaced with an option to use when making payments. You can select from one of the three most recent references, rather than retyping the transaction reference and amount.

### How to access this reference in the new Internet Banking

Rather than retyping the reference, you can simply select from one of the three most recent transaction references, which will also include the amount. Select **Move Money** from the menu, then **Pay Anyone**. Choose the Payee that you would like to pay, then follow these four steps:

1. Select past payments
2. Select one of the last three payments
3. The reference and amount will now appear in the Amount and Description fields
4. Select Now, Later or Repeating to complete the transaction.
